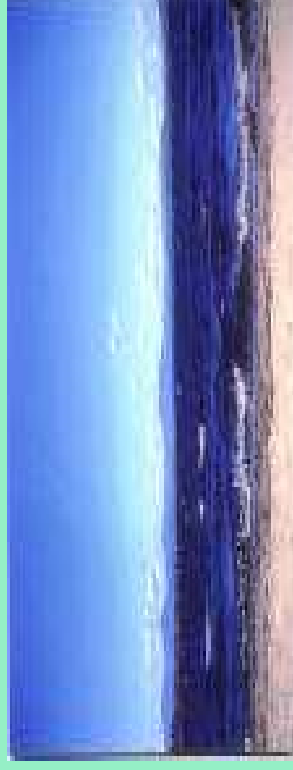

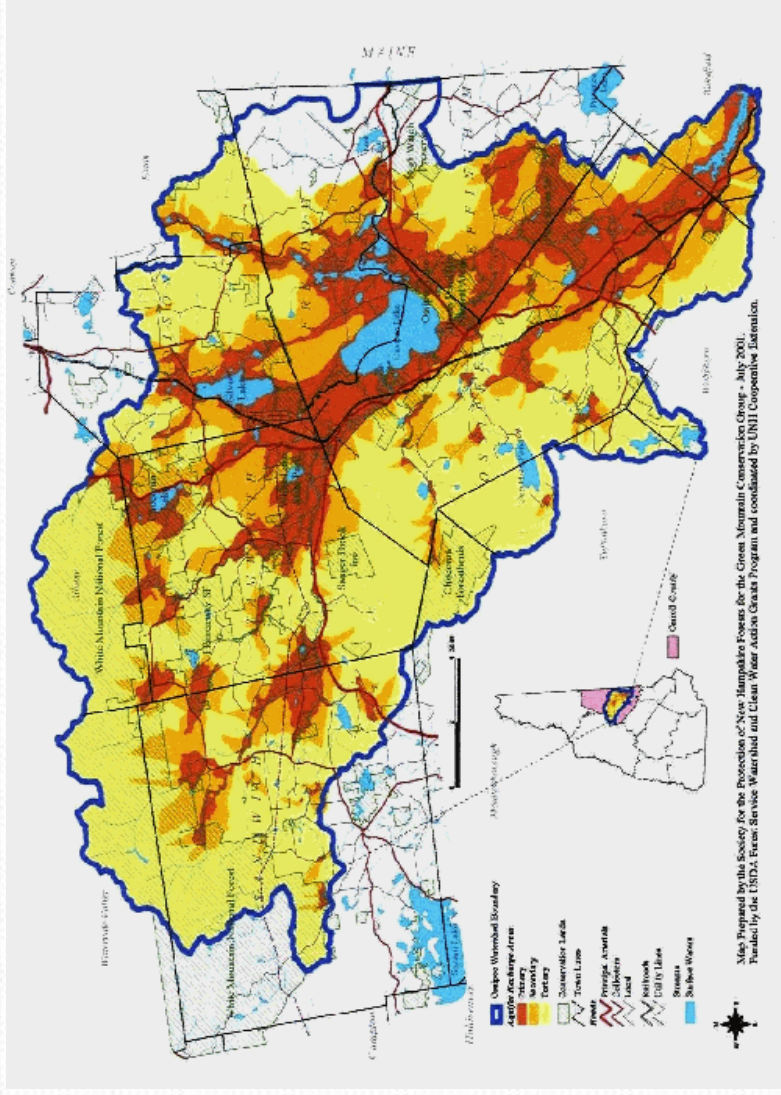

GMCG Founded in 1997

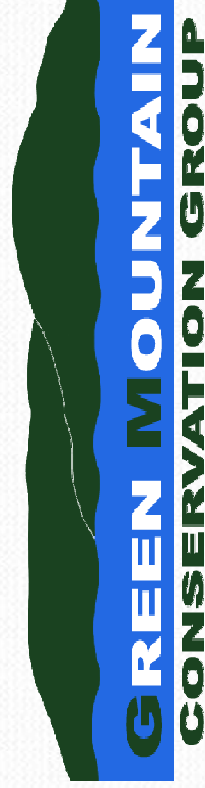

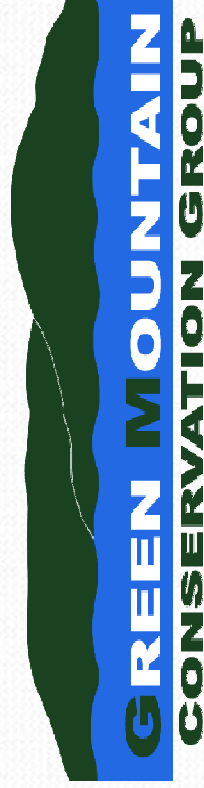

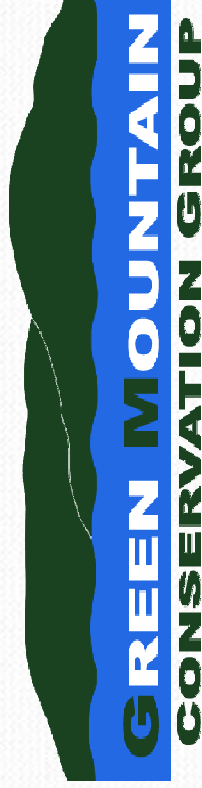
